

**ZCCR 2009 Fall Foliage turn-list to accompany the highlighted map. (MILEAGE IS APPROXIMATE)**

**PINK** Highlighted Routes heading generally South to Naples:

Departing 'downtown' Victor turn **left-South** onto **Rt 444 from Rt. 96 (Main Street)**

Proceed 1.5 miles to **Boughton Hill Road, turn left** at blinking light

Proceed 0.5 miles to **Brace Road, turn right**

Proceed to 4.0 miles **North Bloomfield Road**, turn left at stop sign

Proceed to 0.5 miles **Cooley Road, turn right**

Proceed 2.5 miles to **Rt's 5 & 20, turn left** at stop sign (NOTE: 5 & 20 include a 90 degree bend in this stretch, stay on 5 & 20)

Proceed about 2.5 miles to **Parrish Road** (small street sign on left, comes up fast, **turn left** (this will take you past FF Thompson Hospital – keep going down the hill ... )

Proceed about 1.0 miles to **West Lake Road, turn right** at the signal

Continue about 9.0 miles on West Lake Road along Canandaigua Lake, **(when in doubt keep hugging the shoreline)**, go slow, soak in the lake views, fall colors and beautiful home & properties

Proceed to **Seneca Castle Road**, (rising up a tall hill) **turn left** at the intersection

Proceed about 4 miles **on Seneca Castle Road Rd**, it passes Bristol Harbour Golf Course & Resort, then eventually **narrows to almost a single lane becoming Bopple Road** which continues on **(when in doubt keep hugging the shoreline)**,

Proceed on **Bopple** to **State Route Rt. 21, turn left** at the 't' (steep rise, keep your clutch foot at the ready)

Proceed 1.5 miles to intersection with **Rt. 64, turn right** at the stop sign.

Almost immediately(0.2 miles) **turn left onto County Road 12**, (Arbor Hill Winery is on the right just beyond our turn – we'll miss it)

Proceed 2.5 miles to hilltop scenic overlook parking lot on your left

Take photo's, enjoy the upland views of the lake, hills and colors

Depart this parking lot **turning left**, continuing briefly **on County Road 12**

Proceed 0.5 miles to **Griesa Hill Road, turn left** going downhill, check out the three old barn/garages.

Proceed 1.0 miles to **State Route 21, merge right** at the stop sign, drive into and through the Village of Naples, Joseph's Farm Market will be about 3.0 miles away on your left. Stop & get a pumpkin, some flowers or a pie perhaps. See Page 2 for the Blue Route turn list ...

**Blue** Highlighted Routes heading generally North to Canandaigua:

Depart Joseph's heading **South on State Route 21** for a brief distance, **stay left** and **proceed South on State Route 53**, going a total of 1.2 miles **proceed to County Route 21/Italy Valley Road** (Italy Valley on sign post), **turn left**

Proceed 5.5 miles on this twisty road staying on the main well paved highway until coming to a true **fork in the road** having a general store in its crotch – **BEAR LEFT staying on Italy Valley Road**

Proceed 8.5 miles through the valley to **Friend Road, turn left** at the stop sign

Proceed 0.5 miles to **State Route 364, turn left** at the stop sign.

NOTE: in about 1.0 miles Rt. 364 will bear off sharply to the left where State Route 247 continues on to the right) **BE PREPARED TO STOP AND TURN LEFT TO STAY ON Rt. 364**).

Proceed about 3.0 miles to Middlesex where **Rt. 364 twists around but stay on it**.

Having left Middlesex in your rear view mirror, **continue on Rt. 364**

Proceed about 2.0 miles to **Vine Valley Road, turn left**

Proceed about 2.0 miles towards the lake to a **'t' in the road** where you must **turn right onto East Lake Road**. NOTE: for the next half-mile or so **this gets interesting**, the road includes a **bend left, into a 180 degree right-hand uphill curve, then you must make a hard left** to stay on **East lake Road**

Proceed on **East Lake Road** about 7.0 miles along the lake to another 't', you must **turn left** at the stop sign onto **State Route 364** again.

Continue driving along Rt. 364 5.0 miles or so (now also East Lake Road), **turn left onto Lakeshore Drive** (Valero Gas Station on corner)

Keep going on Lakeshore Drive, enjoying the view at the park across the head of the lake, **when Sutter's Marina is on your left the NY Wine & Culinary Center is immediately in front of you**. You must **turn left (very hard left)** then park in front of the NYWCC or in its side or rear parking lots. Go in, enjoy the building and all it has to offer. There were no nails used – its interior is made with exposed vintage barn wood that's pegged-together. Beer & wine tasting, a gift shop and demo/training kitchens occupy the first floor. The second floor has a restaurant and a separate bar/pub area plus a wrap-around elevated exterior deck. Food prices are reasonable, selections range from simple to sexy to suit your adventure for a taste sensation. Time Warner is sponsoring a tent out back where you can score various types of fresh NYS apples.

If continuing on, rejoin South Main Street (becomes Rt. 332 running North through the downtown section of Canandaigua eventually leading to the Ontario Antique Mall on your left. **You must drive past the mall and do a convenient u-turn to get to their parking lot**. When heading home, just rejoin **Rt 332 North to get to Exit 44 of the NYS Thruway (US Route 90)**.
